- 2. The achievement must have been attained within the six month period prior to the date of application.
- 3. Applications will only be accepted on behalf of students aged from 4 years to 18 years inclusive.
- 4. An award will only be considered where the Trustees deem that a standard of excellence has been achieved in either a sporting, artistic, dance or music area. This would normally be a representative honour or performance selection at either a County level, National or International/Olympic level. Trustees may recognise other achievements where an applicant has achieved recognition in the face of adversity.
- 5. Applicants will only be considered for one grant at the same level in any 12 month period.
- 6. Applications are not financially assessed.
