Criteria for a Standard of Excellence Award:

1. The student to whom the application relates must reside in the Town of Evesham both at the time of the achievement and at the time of application.
2. The achievement must have been attained within the six month period prior to the date of application.
3. Applications will only be accepted on behalf of students aged from 4 years to 18 years inclusive.
4. An award will only be considered where the Trustees deem that a standard of excellence has been achieved in either a sporting, artistic, dance or music area. This would normally be a representative honour or performance selection at either a County level, National or International/Olympic level. Trustees may recognise other achievements where an applicant has achieved recognition in the face of adversity.
5. Applicants will only be considered for one grant at the same level in any 12 month period.
6. Applications are not financially assessed.
7. If approved, Award's are normally paid directly to the student in recognition of their achievement.
