FURTHER/HIGHER EDUCATION GRANTS ACADEMIC YEAR 2024 – 2025

The Charity is pleased to invite Students to apply for an Education Grant.

To qualify for a grant, you must meet the required age as at 1 September 2024.

You must also be a permanent resident of the TOWN OF EVESHAM or, if living away from home during term time, maintain a residential address in the TOWN.

All applicants must provide documentation to evidence their residency. Applicants aged 25 and over are also subject to a financial assessment.

Grants are available for the following courses:

CATEGORY A: HND, Degree level and Postgraduate courses at a University or College.
Full or part time,
Age: 18 to state retirement age.

CATEGORY C: Part time vocational or educational courses, other than degree level.
Courses must be classed as a part time course by the educational establishment and can be part of a modern apprenticeship/day release.
Courses must run for 3 terms or equivalent (60 hours minimum over an academic year). Recreational courses are excluded.
Age: 16 to state retirement age.

CATEGORY D: Vocational courses towards Degrees at the Open University or Degree level distance learning.
Age: 18 to state retirement age.

The application periods will close at 1pm on the following dates. Late applications will not be considered under any circumstances.

CATEGORY C: 30 June 2025
